Automated decision-making

How long we store personal data

Broshuis B.V. stores your personal data no longer than strictly necessary to reach the initial goal. We have certain storage terms for the following categories of personal data:

- Persons interested in investments goods often buy once in 10 years.
- We therefore need the data for a maximum of 10 years and we do store it that long.
- If there is no activity after 10 years, the account will expire.
- Application letters are kept in accordance with the applicable legal guidelines.

Sharing personal data with third parties

Broshuis B.V. exclusively provides personal data with third parties if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you, or if we need to comply with a legal obligation.

Cookies, or similar techniques that we use

Broshuis B.V. uses functional, analytical and tracking cookies.
